Whereas the Proprietary and Gov^r upon an Agree^{mt} made between Dan^l Falkner, Joannes Kelpius & Joannes Sawert Agents for the German St. francford Company of Purchasers and Rob^t Nailor did grant a Warr^t to the sd Rob^t to take up eighty Acres of Land in the Liberties of ye City Philad^{ia} locating the same by an Error on Land preengaged to Hugh Rob^{ts} which Warr^t for the sd reason could not be executed. And the sd German Agents requesting us to renew ye Grant of ye sd Number of Acres to be laid out to themselves being the remainder of Liberty Land due on their ^{Constituents} purchase of fifteen thousand Acres. These are to Authorize thee to survey or cause to be survey'd to the sd Agents for and in behalf of the sd Company the sd Number of eighty Acres of Land within the sd Liberties where not already survey'd and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office. Given under our hands & seal of ye Province ~~of Pensylvania~~ at Philad^{ia} 17th 10^{mo} 1701.
