


Reputed Silas Crispins Land



Pursuant to a warrant from the
Comiss^rs of property directed unto me
bearing date ye 1st of ye 2^d m^o 1702. I do

Certify yt I have Surveyed ye ²¹ of ye 3^d m^o 1703 unto Vacant Land
Randl Spickman in Right of Daniel Smith a Certaine tract of Land Reputed to
be in ye County of Philadelphia begining at a stak-by a Hickry Sapline marked
being a corner of a tract of Land Laid out for Silas Crispin from thence by the
said Land North West 242 perches to a stak-set in ye ground in ye said Crisp-
ines Reputed Line. thence by a Line of trees and Vacant Land North 480 perches
to another stak-set in ye ground. Neere a w^t oke marked from thence by Vacant Land
South East by a Line of marked trees 242 perches to another stak-by blah. oke
marked from thence by a Line of trees marked deviding it from ye Proprietors
Land South 480 perches to ye plac-of begining. Containing 500 accrs of Land
and is according to ye bounds above described. Return'd into ye General
Survey^rs Offic-at Philadelphia ye 14th day of ye 4th m^o 1703.
