These are to will & require thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto him ye s<sup>d</sup> Number of Acres in ye aforemention'd County where not already taken up according to ye Method of Townships appointed by me, he seating & improving ye same w<sup>th</sup> in Six Mo<sup>th</sup>s after ye Date of Survey, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office Given at Philadelphia ye 16<sup>th</sup> of ye 5<sup>th</sup> mo. 1684.
