These are to require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd to the said John Swift a city Lott ^{in Philadelphia on Delaware side} proportionable to his said purchase in as convenient a place as can be found not otherwise appropriated and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office.
