



By Vertue of a Warr^t from Edward Pennington Survey^r Generall bearing date ye 27 of ye 5 m^o 1700 directed unto me Thereby Certiefy into his office that I have Survey'd & Laid out unto Thomas Story Attorney for Joseph Pick a Certain^e tract of Land in the City Liberty beginning at a Gume tree marked in the Line of William Roberts Land from thenc^e East on hund and Seventy perches to a set in the ground from thenc^e South by a Line of marked trees Ninty four^e ^{& a q^t} perches to a another Stak^e Sett in the ground from thenc^e west one hundred and seventy perches to a another Stak^e in the Line of ye Said William Roberts from thenc^e by a Line of marked trees North Ninty four^e ^{& a q^t} perches to the first mentioned Gume tree Containing and Laid out for one hundred acres of Land the 4th of ye 6 m^o Ensueing ye Dat^e above sd Pr^o me
