

I do hereby Certifie that by vertue of a warrant under the hands of the Commissioners of Property and the Seal of the Province to Isaac Taylor directed bearing date the 16th of 17th 1701. The said Isaac Taylor hath made Returns into the General Surveyors Office of the Resurvey of a piece of Land Resurvey'd to Francis Chadsey the ninth of the 2^d month 1702 which being examined and Revised in the said office is as followeth viz^t - Situate in the Manor of Recklands beginning at a black oke in the line of Concord Township from thence extending in the said line North 24 degr^s Westerly Seventy perches to a corner hickory thence west South west by the lands of James Chivers Edward Wilbourn and John Chalfan two hundred ninety eight perches to a Spanish oak thence South south east in Nathaniel Newlirs line Seventy perches to a Maple tree Thence east northeast two hundred ninety nine perches to the place of beginning Contairring one hundred and thirty acres
