


PensilvaniaCopy d^aBy the Commission ^{is} of Property

These are to authorize & require thee forthwith to Survey and lay out to the sd Ann Cally according to the Method of Townships appointed the said quantity of five hundred Acres of land in this Province that has not been already Surveyd nor taken up nor is concealed nor seated by the Indians and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadia where this Warrt is to remain and a copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands & the Seal of the Province at Philadia the 28th of the 4th Moth 1703
