at Susquahanna: These are in ye Proprietary's name to will & require thee  
to Survey or cause to be Surveyed unto him ye sd two hundred acres of  
Land in ye aforesd place he seating & improving ye same w<sup>th</sup> in one year  
from ye date of Survey & make returns thereof into ye Secretary's Office  
Given at Philadelphia ye 17<sup>th</sup> 9<sup>th</sup> m<sup>o</sup> 1684
