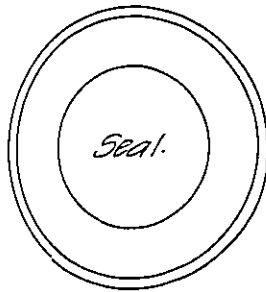


Pennsylvania



William Penn True and absolute Proprietary and Governour of the Province of Pennsylvania & Territories thereunto belonging.

At the Request of Saml & Joshua Carpenter Griffith Jones & Comp^{rs} that I would grant them a Resurvey on a certain Tract of Land in the County of Chester Survey'd to Cha: Pickering for four thousand eight hundred and seventy eight Acres. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey or cause to be resurvey'd the said Tract according to its first bounds & lines of Survey with this Alteration only that thou shalt take off from the Southermost side thereof five hundred acres and add ye like quantity to the head of the s^d Tract and make Returns into my Secres Office. Given under my hand and Seal the 10th day of 8^{br} 1701
