At the Request of Joseph Cloud that we would grant him to take up One hundred acres of head land under the usual Rent, fifty thereof in Right of Richard ffarr and the other fifty in right of Mary ffarr his wife who came into this Province serv't to Jno Bezer and convey'd their whole right to the sd Land to the said Joseph Cloud for a valuable consideration recd for the same. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey and lay out to the said Joseph Cloud the said quantity of One hundred Acres of Land in this Province where not already Survey'd nor taken up nor is concealed nor seated by the Indians and make Returns thereof into the General Surveyor's Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee Certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 13th of the 11th Moth 170³/₄
