

Pursuant to a Warrant under the hand and Seal of the Proprietary and Governour bearing date the 17th of the 7th month 1701 Granting unto Bartholomew Coppock Junior a Resurvey on a Certain Tract of land in the Township of Springfield and County of Chester. Laid out for 400 acres in Right of his purchase of seven hundred and fifty acres jointly with his Cousin Bartholomew Coppock Sen^r and is in their possession.

There is Resurvey'd unto Bartholomew Coppock Junior and Bartholomew Coppock Sen^r. a Tract of Land in the township of Springfield and the County of Chester. Containing five hundred and twenty acres and the same equally divided between them the one Moiety thereof being in the possession of Bartholomew Coppock Sen^r. Beginning at a Corner post in the line of Isaac Taylor's land from thence extending South fifty five degrees westerly in the said line three hundred and three perches to a white oak by Crum Creek thence up the said Creek on several Courses the distances on the said Courses being added together 352 Pches. to a Spanish Oak by the said Creek from thence North fifty five degr^s in the line of Edward Dars his land two hundred and forty six perch_{es} to a corner post from thence by the land of Bartholomew Coppock Junior (being the other Moiety of the said 520 Acres) South fifty five degrees easterly one hundred and thirty perches to the place of beginning Contain_{ing} two hundred and sixty acres.
