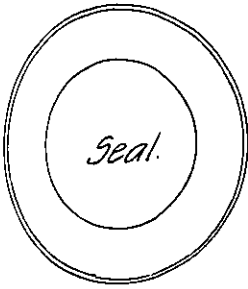


PennsylvaniaBy the Commission<sup>rs</sup> of Property.
