


Pennsylvania



By the Commissioners of Property

Whereas Joseph Cloud Sen^r of the County of Chester hath made it appear to us that he came with the first adventurers a servant into this Province to Mr^r Bezer and hath thereupon requested us that we would grant him to take up his Right in Head Land in this Province pursuant to y^e Proprietaries Concessions in that case made and granted. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey and lay out to the sd Joseph Cloud ~~the~~ fifty Acres of Land in the County of Chester where not already Survey'd nor taken up nor is conceal'd nor seated by the Indians and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by y^e Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 23^d of the 12th Month 1702
