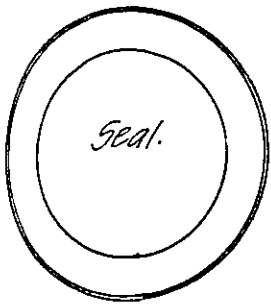


Pennsylvania *f.*

By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of Nathan Dicks of the County of Chester that we would grant him three Hundred Acres or thereabouts of Vacant Land near the head of Otteraroe in the County of Chester for which he hath agreed to pay to the Proprietor's Use forthwith after Survey after the rate of ten pounds P. Hundred Acres. These are to Authorize thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the said Nathan Dicks in the place afores^d the said quantity of three hundred ^{acres} or more if he desire it of vacant land that has not been already Survey'd nor taken up nor is seated by the Indians and make return thereof into the Secretaries Office. Which Survey in case the said Nathan fulfill the said Agreement shall be valid otherwise the same shall be void as if it had never been made nor this Warr^t ever granted. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 11th day of November AD. 1713
