At ye request of ye undernamed Persons that their Purchase and headland might be layed out about Nashamein Creek These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyd unto John Evans 400 acres Purchase Land and behind it 100 Acres head land for him self & his son; to Ellis Jones 100 Acres Purchase Land & 50 acres head land for himself: to Tho: Jones 150 acres Purchase Land & ~~50 Acres head land for himself~~ to Evan Oliver 200 Acres Purchase Land and 100 Acres headland for himself & wife To Roger Hughes 250 Acres Purchase Land in a place not already taken up alwaies observing ye ye headlands be survey'd behinde ye purchased land according to ye regulation of Townships appointed by me and make returns thereof into my Secretarys Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 19th of ye 1st Mo. 1683
