Whereas on the tenth day of the fifth month 1683 was laid out unto Thomas Ellis in the Towneship of Marlpoole three hundred & thirty acres over & above what he had purchased of the Propriet^r I do by vertue of a warr^t from the Proprietaries Com^{rs} beareing date the seaventh day of ye first month 169 ^{$\frac{3}{4}$} make Returne of the sd Survey w^{ch} is as followeth, that is to say it begineth at a Corner post by Darby Creek thence W: S: W: by Radrit^r Towneship 196 perches to a Corner post thence S: S: E: by a line of trees 192 perches to a Corner black oak thence N: E: & B: E by William Howells Land 392 perches to a Corner oak by the afores^d Darby Creek thence up the severall Courses thereof to ye place of beginning and was accordingly Entred into my Office at Philadelphia the twentieth day of the twelfth month 1683
