would grant him to take up two hundred Acres of Land in ye County of Chester:
formerly taken up by Caleb Pusey
These are to will & require thee forthwth to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto
him ye sd number of Acres in ye aforementioned County where not already taken
up according to ye method of Townships appointed by me & make returns there-
of into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 29th 3d mo 1684
For Thomas Holmes Wm. Penn
Surveyor General.

16th 4th mo 84 ordered C.A. to lay it out, provided C. Pusey declines it.
