

John Evans the said quantity of two hundred Acres of Land situuate as afores^d and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd. thee certified by the Secretary who is to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 18th of the 12th Moth 1701
