At the Request of Rachel Ellis that we would grant her a Resurvey on two several Tracts of Land in the Welch Tract the one reputed to contain one hundred and eleven Acres laid out in Haverford in a Tract of 791 Acres and is the remainder thereof devised to the said Rachel by her father Thomas Ellis in his last will and the other laid out by virtue of a General Warrant from the Proprietor for Surveying the said Tract for two hundred and fifty Acres in Cluffein Mawr in right also of the said Thomas-his Purchaser by him devised to his son Humphry of whom the sd Rachel-purchased the same. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the said Rachel Ellis the said two several tracts the one of One hundred and eleven Acres and the other of Two hundred and fifty Acres in the several places where already located and make Returns thereof into the general Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delved to thee certified by ye Secret<sup>y</sup> who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office.
