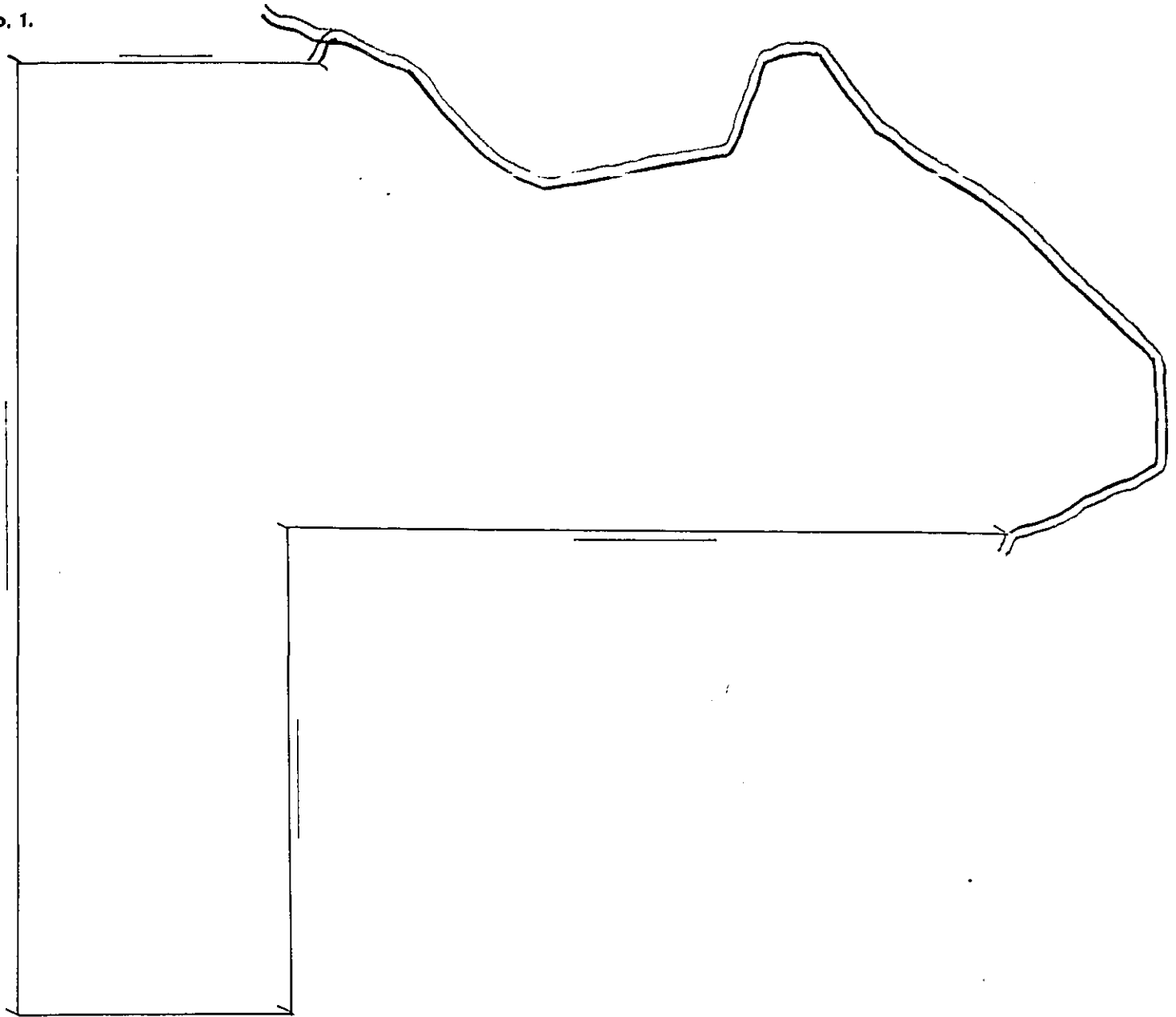

S 52 Perches to a marked whitte oke being a corner tree of Georg Simcocks Land from thence along the sd. Simcock Line of marked trees W b. N. 230 Perches to ye sd. Simcock other corner tree being a whitte oke from thence 56 W along the sd. Simcocks Line of marked trees to a Red oke from thence W. b. N. 86 Perches to a spanish oke from thence E. b. S. to a mapell tree standing by darbey Creek and along the sd. Creeke one severall Courses to the first menchered Red oke.
