



By ye Comission^{rs} Impowerd to grant Lotte & Lands in ye Province of Pennsylvania & ye Territories thereunto belonging.

At ye Request of Keels Laerson Friend yt wee would grant him a Resurvey of his Land in ye Township of Upland being one hundred fifty Acres according to ye Patent from ye Govern^r of New York 1669 & if in ye exact Survey any ^{more} Land^s should be found yt he might have it paying for ye same as others: These are in ye Proprietary's Name to will & require thee to resurvey or cause a resurvey to be made running one mile long into ye woods & of equal breadth in ye woods as allowed in the front of ye aforesd tract of Land & make a true Return thereof wth what is more into ye Secretary's Office, yt, as He desireth, a Patent may be prepared for it. Given at Philadelphia ye 4th of ye 12th Mo 1684.
