At the Request of Reuben Ford of the County of Chester that we would grant them to take up fifty acres of head-land as his Right for his Servitude to ~~his~~ Jno Gibbons in this Province according to the Proprietors Concessions. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey and lay out to the said Reuben Ford the said quantity of fifty Acres of Land in this Province that has not been already taken up nor is concealed nor Seated by the Indians to be held at ye yearly Quitrent of a half penny Sterl. P. Acre and make Returns into the Genl Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warrt is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd. to thee certified by ye Secry. Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} 16th 9th 1703
