By the Commissioners of Property

At the Request of Joseph Davis of the City of Philad^a. Barber that we would Grant him to inclose one Square of Ground Situate between Mulberry Street & High Street and between the Tenth and eleventh Streets from the river Delaware and that he may hold the Same for the Space of one & Twenty years ensuing the date hereof for which He agrees to pay to the use of the Proprietary or Trustees of the Province forty Shilling Sterling Money of Great Britain yearly during the said Term and at the expiration thereof to Deliver up and Surrender the Same under a Good fence and well improved These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey and lay out or cause to be Survey'd & laid out unto the Said Joseph Davis in the Place aforesaid the Said Square of Ground To be by him held under y^e Said yearly rents of forty Shillings Sterling which in case the Said Joseph yearly & duly fulfill & pay Then this Survey shall be for the Said Term Valid otherwise the Same is to be Void as if it had not been made nor this Warrant ever granted Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 30th day of October Anno Din 1719.
