



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Commissioners to me directed bearing date the 29th day of the 7th month 1702, ^{To} Resurvey and lay out unto William Say 100 acres of Land, formerly Laid out to Robert Wheeler in one Tract, Resurveyed and Laid out unto the said William Say one Moyety of the said tract. Beginning at a heap of stones by a white oak sapling on the great hill end. Thence by vacant Land North West 51. p. to a Post, Then by Margaret Atkinson's land North East 336. per. to a small white oak dead. Then by James Streater's land South East 51. p. to a Post. Then by the other part of the Tract South West 336 perches to the beginning. Containing 107 acres. Resurveyed and Laid out the 20th day of the first month in the year 170²/₃
