By vertue of a warrant from ye Com^{rs} dated ye 24th of ye 9th M^o 1686 directed to ye Survey^r Generall. I do by Authority from him Certifie into ye Secretaryes office that there was Surveyed and Laid out ye 24th of ye 5th M^o 1688 unto Daniell Smÿth Purchas^r of two Thousand acres. his Lott in ye Libertyes of ye City of Philadelphia. Beginning at a Corn^r post of Thomas Callo hills Land. thence W.S.W by ye same one hundred and thirteen perches. thence N.N.W. by a line of trees fourty five p^rches. thence E.N.E. by a line of trees one hundred ~~thirteen~~ thirteen p^rches to a Corn^r post by a Street or Road. thence S.S.E. by ye same fourty five p^rches to ye place of Beginning. Containing Thirty Two acres of Land and is Accordingly Entred and Recorded in ye Survey^r Gener^l office at Philadelphia ye 12th of ye 4th M^o 1689.
