



In pursuance of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the 10th of 7^{br} 1717 for Surveying to David Powel of Philad^a Surveyor three thousand acres of Land in this Province this may certifie that there is Surveyd to John Ledrah in part of the Said 3000[—] the quantity of One hundred acres of Land in the County of Philadelphia. Beginning at a corner of Gilman Colph Land and running from thence South West by Vacant Land and the Land of Jacob Colph one hundred and three perches. Then North West by a Line of trees one hundred fifty eight perches. then North East One hundred and three perches then South East One hundred fifty eight perches to the place of Beginning.
