

then surveyed for W<sup>m</sup> ~~\_\_\_\_\_~~ Smith 739 acres lieng on the west side  
of Scool creek Joyneng to the creek. begining at a marked red oak  
neer the sd Creek and running W into the woods 620 perch to A marked  
Spanish oak. then N. 190 perch to A marked white oak. from thence  
running E by W<sup>m</sup> Powels line of marked trees 620 perch to the sd.  
Powels marked Corner tree being a white oak standing neer the  
School creek, from thence along the creek side to the first mar-  
ked tree.
