The Tract Purchased of David Powell begins at a White Oak in a line of Hans Clemers land. thence by the same South West sixteen perches to a post. thence by the said Clemer South East Ninety five perches to a post. thence by the said Hans Clemer South West Eighty Eight Perches And by Land of Tilman Colb Sixteen perches to a post thence by the s^d Tilman Colb South West one hundred and sixty six perches to a post. thence by Vacant Land North East one hundred and Twenty perches to a White Oak. thence by Vacant land South East Six perches & by land of Christian Allowbaugh the same Course Sixty five perches to the place of Beginning. Containing One hundred & Eighty Acres with the usual allowance of Six & Cent.
