

Laid out for John Summers a Certain Tract of Land in the County of Philadelphia and within the Dublin Township. Beginning at a post standing in the line of Jo: James Land being the Corner of the Land of Hugh Goude and from thence North East by the said Gouds Land 480 perches to a post for another Corner. and from thence South East by Va-Land or the Susquahanah Road 167 perches to another post for a corner. Thence South West by the Land of Joseph Calsheton ~~480~~ 480 perches to a post for another Corner. Thence North West by said Jo: James Land 167 perches to the first mentioned Corner. post. containeing five hundred acres of Land.
