

 By ye Comission<sup>rs</sup> impowerd to grant Lotts & Land in ye

 & building upon ye Lott & improve ye Land according to Regula-  
 tion w.<sup>th</sup> in six Months from ye Date of Survey, & make returns  
 thereof into ye Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye  
 20<sup>th</sup> of ye 3<sup>d</sup> M<sup>o</sup> 1685.
