Powell of the City of Philadelphia Surveyor Three Thousand Acres of

Land in this Province. There was Survey'd and Laid out in Becember 1717

To Gabriel Shooler a Certain Tract or Parcel of Land in the County of Philadelphia. Begining at a Post at a Corner of Clause Johnsons Land Then

by the Same North West One hundred and Tenperches to a Post. Then

South west One hundred and fifty Two perches to a Post in the line

of Hans Reifts Land. Then by the Same South East One hundred &

Ten perches to a Post. Then North East One hundred & fifty Two perches to the place of Begining. Containing One hundred and four

Acres.

Certified at Philodelphia this 18th day of May 1720.
