



In Pursuance of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property Dated the Tenth Day of September 1717 for Surveying unto David Powell of the City of Philadelphia Surveyor Three Thousand Acres of Land in this Province. There was Survey'd and Laid out in December 1717 To Gabriel Shooler a Certain Tract or Parcel of Land in the County of Philadelphia. Beginning at a Post at a Corner of Clause Johnsons Land. Then by the Same North West One hundred and Ten perches to a Post. Then South west One hundred and fifty Two perches to a Post in the line of Hans Reifts Land. Then by the Same South East One hundred & Ten perches to a Post. Then North East One hundred & fifty Two perches to the place of Beginning. Containing One hundred and four Acres.

Certified at Philadelphia this 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 1720.
