By vertue of a warr from ye Proprietary and Govern^r dated ye 13th of ye first M^o 1683. directed to ye Survey^r Generall. I do by Authority from him Cer-ti-fie into ye Secretaryes office that there was Surveyed and Laid out ye same day Three hundred acres of Land in ye County of Philadelphia. unto John Southworth (being part of his Purchase of five hundred acres of Land) begining at a Corn^r post of Mathias Soulys Land thence N. E. by ye same 480 p^{ches}, thence N. W. by a Street or Road 100 p^{ches}. from thence S. W. by Richard Coats Land 480 p^{ches}. from thence S. E. by a line of trees 100 p^{ches} to ye place of begining which is accordingly Entred and Recorded in ye Survey^r Generalls Office at Philadelphia ye 8th of ye 3^d M^o 1693.
