At ye Request of John Songhurst, y^t I would grant him to take up ye Land wthin ye Liberties of ye City of Philadelphia proportionable to his own & his Daughter, Elizabeth Barber Widdow. Purchase of Three Thousand Acres. These are to will & require thee forthwth to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto him wthin ye Liberty on Delaware side Sixty Acres of Land where not taken up according to ye Method of Townships appointed by me & make returns thereof in to my ~~Secr~~ Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 26th ^{mo} 4th 1683.
