At ye Request of Matthias Souly, late Purchaser of Three hundred Acres of Land. y^t I would grant him to take up a Lott in ye City of Philadelphia: These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him a Lott in ye City on thar side of Delaware (in Winn Street call'd) fourty foot in front. & in length as other Lotts of ye sd Street run. & make returns there of into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 2^d 9th 1683.
