These are to will and require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye said Number of Acres in ye aforementioned place, provided it be not already taken up, according to ye method of Township appointed by me, and make returns there of into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 13th of ye 1st M^o 1683.
