Southebe <sup>and-</sup> that wee would grant unto him a Lott Adjoyning to ye Common landing at ye End of ye Second Street fronting ye Runn On ye Proprietarys Land at ye North End of Philadelphia, in Consideration that he forthwith Improve and build on the Same, wee have granted it.

These are there fore in the Proprietarys Name to will and Require Thee forthwith to Survey or Lay out or Cause to be Survey'd and Laid out unto him ye Said Lott of Land and make Returne thereof to ye Secretarys Office. Dated at Philadelphia the 14<sup>th</sup> of ye 12<sup>th</sup> month 1697.
