

Survey'd and Layd out to Andrew Sandell of the County of Philadelphia Gent. a Piece of Ground Lying between the Land Where on he now dwells the Land of Peter ~~Swanson~~<sup>Cock</sup> and the River Schuylkil. Beginning at the top of a Rock by the said River Schuylkil Near the Mouth of a Run which divides this Land from the Land formerly Peter Rambows. Then by the said Sandels<sup>other land</sup> North thirty degrees East fifty six perches to the North Side of the ferry Road. Then North Eighty five degrees East thirty two perches. Then East by South fourteen perches. Then South East thirty Six perches. Then East South East thirty two perches. all these lines by the said Sandels other Land. Then North West by the said Peter ~~Swanson~~<sup>Cock</sup> his land Ninety perches to the Edge of the Swamp & Continuing the same Course about forty perches to the Water of Schuylkil. Then down the same on several Courses about one hundred and ten perches to the place of Beginning. Containing fast Land twelve acres and of Swamp about Eight acres and a half.

Returned into the Secretarys Office the 30<sup>th</sup> of May Anno. 1718.
