


Pennsilvania

By vertue of a Warrant from ye Com^{ee} dated ye 8th of ye 12th m^o 1687^{1/2} Directed
to ye Survey^r Generall. I do by Authority from him Certifie into ye Secreta-
ryes Office that there was Surveyed and Laid out ye 24th of ye 5th m^o 1688 unto Dan-
iel Smyth in right of Thomas Hatt Purchas^t offire hundred acres his Lott in ye
Libertyes of Philadelphia. Proportionable thereto. Begining at a Corn^r post
of Daniell Smyths Land Standing by a Street or Road. thence W.S.W. by ye
said Smyths Land One hundred and thirteen perches. thence N.N.W. by a
Line of trees Elaven p'ches. thence E.N.E. by a line of trees one hundred
and thirteen p'ches to a Corn^r post Standing by ye afore mentioned Street
or Road. thence S.S.E. by ye same Elaven p'ches to ye place of begining
Containing Eight acres of Land. And is accordingly Entred and Recorded
in ye Survey^r Generalls Office at Philadelphia ye 12th of ye 4th M^o 1689.
