



Prsuant to a Gen^l Warrant under the hand and Seal of the Proprietors and Governo^r to me directed bareing date the 12th day of the Eighth moth 1703 for surveying of his Severall Mannors and all the Lands wth in the Libertyes of the City of Philadelphia. and for the fixing the Exact bounds & limits thereof. I doe hereby Certifye that I have Resurveyed unto Thomas Story in right of Richard Sneads Purchas of 1500 Acres. And Hen: Waddys purchase of 500^a acertaine tract of Land scituate in the Northeⁿ Liberties. Begining at a post by a small hickry strubb in the line of Hance Neues his Land. (late in the Possession of Francis Plumsted) being neare a large black oake in the line of Tho: Bowmans Land. from thence by the same East North East 34 perches to a post in a Thicket. Thence by Edw: Luffs Land north north west 56 perches to a post. Thence East North East 12 perches to a post. Thence North North West 63 perches to a post. Thence West and by North 55 perches by the Land of the Bristol Township to another post. Thence South South East by Derick Sipmans Liberty Land. 151 perches to the place of begining. 36 Acres of Land. Surveyd the 26th day of the first moth 1777.
