



John Linvell's Land Situate in the County of Lancaster (being part of Eleven Hundred acres Survey'd to James Hendricks the 19th of October 1716) Beginning at post in a Line of Melchior Prenaman's Land thence by the Same and the Land of Hans Moyer North by West 222 pches to a post. thence West South West by Thomas Gale's Land 163 pches to a Hickery. thence South Sixteen degrees East by Thomas Baldwin's Land 222 pches to a post. then East North East by Jeremiah Langhorn's Land 147 pches to the Beginning. Containing two Hundred Acres & the Allowance of Six Acres & Cent.
