



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the fifth day of November 1719 for the Laying Out 1000^{ac} of Land to Samuel Powell in Right of John Cole. Surveyed to ^{sd} Samuel Powell 500^{ac} part of 5^d 1000^{ac}. Situate in the County of Bucks. Beginning at a black Oak a Corner of a tract of land laid Out to an Indian Named Tallamie. thence by the ^{sd} tract East 230 perches to a post, thence by Vacant Land South 294 perches to a White Oak, thence by Vacant Land West 374 P^s to a post. thence by Vacant land North 120 perches to a post, thence by land of William Allen East 144 perches to a W^t oak, thence by William Allen North 174 perches to the place of Beginning. Containing 500^{ac} with ye usual Allowance of Six & Cent.
