 I survey'd to Lewis Lewis of New-Town in the County of Chester a
 Certain Tract of Land in ye sd County, situate on ye Western Branch of
 Conestogoe Creek. Begining at Corner Marked Forked Elme Tree stand-
 ing on ye Northern side of ye said Branch, thence North North West
 by a line of Marked Trees sixty Perches to a Black oak, thence North
 One hundred forty five perches to a small Hickery, thence East
 North East 268 perches to a Black oak, thence South 210 perches
 to a Post, thence West South West 243 perches to ye Place of Beq-
ining. Containing 300 acres with ye Allowance of 6 p^t cent.
