



By Virtue of A Warrant from The Commissioners of Property bearing Date the Twentieth Day of May 1719. Surveyed And laid out for Thomas Miller millwright a Certain Tract of land Scituate on Manahatany Creek near Oley In the County of Philad^a. begining at A Corner Stake of Jn^o. Longworthys Land. Thence by the same South Seventy Degrees ~~West~~ one hundred Twenty And one perches to A Second Stake Put for a Corner. Thence by Vacant Land Noreth Twenty Deg: ~~West~~ Two hundred and Eighty and an half To a small Black oak Saplin-Marked for a Corner. Thence ^{by vac^t land} North Seventy Deg. West one hundred Twenty and One perches To a Third Stake put for a Corner. Thence by Vacant land South Twenty Deg. west Two hundred and Eighty perches and an half To the place of begining. Containing Two hundred Acres. with Allowance of Six # Cent. Surveyed December ye 2 day 1719. #.
