Penn Esq^r. dated ye 25th of the 8th Month 1701. and two hundred & fifty acres & Allowance &c. is the 5^d Joseph Kirkbrides moiety of Tho^s Fullers purchase of 500^a for the taking up of w^{ch} a Warr^t was granted by the late Commissioners to Jeremiah Simmonds dated the 25th 4th M^o 1714 and the rem^t 204^a & Allowance &c. is the 5^d Joseph Kirkbride's purchase of the 5^d Comm^{rs} by Warr^t dated the 10th of 7^{br} 1720.
