



A Draught of a Tract of Land of Joseph Kirkbride, situate near Oley in the County of Philadelphia, surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> of the 2<sup>d</sup> Month Anno Dom. 1737. containing 529 acres & Allowance of six acres & Cent for Roads &c. of w<sup>ch</sup> 75 acres & Allow. &c. is to complete Joseph Kirkbrides moiety of W<sup>m</sup> Pennington's purchase of 1250<sup>a</sup> for the taking of w<sup>ch</sup> a Warr.<sup>t</sup> was granted by the late Proprietary W<sup>m</sup>. Penn Esq.<sup>r</sup> dated ye 25<sup>th</sup> of the 8<sup>th</sup> Month 1701. and two hundred & fifty acres & Allowance &c. is the 5<sup>d</sup> Joseph Kirkbrides moiety of Tho<sup>s</sup> Fullers purchase of 500<sup>a</sup> for the taking up of w<sup>ch</sup> a Warr.<sup>t</sup> was granted by the late Commissioners to Jeremiah Simmonds dated the 25<sup>th</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> M<sup>o</sup> 1714 and the rem<sup>t</sup> 204<sup>a</sup> & Allowance &c. is the 5<sup>d</sup> Joseph Kirkbride's purchase of the 5<sup>d</sup> Comm<sup>rs</sup> by Warr.<sup>t</sup> dated the 10<sup>th</sup> of 7<sup>br</sup> 1720.
