

By Warr t from the late Commes of Property dated the 22d of Feb. 1714-5 the above described Tract of Land was soon after laid out to Jonas Yocom by David Powell but his Return having a very apparent mistake in it, was rejected & the sd Jonas referred to N. Scull to examine the lines &c.

and Other Land of solonas Yocom Stoe 317 perches to a Post in a Line of
George McCalls Mannor, thence by the Same Sow 258 perches to a
Black Walnut Stump on the bank of sol River Schulkill, thence up the
same 236 perches to ye place of Beginning. Containing Three hundred and Fifty Acres with the usual allowance of Six & Cent.
