Copied from a Draught of John Cutler on which other Lands are Drawn and the John Cutler in the 5^d Draught make no mention of Edward Beeson but Daniel Wharley Yet its clear from E. Beeson's Warr^t above recited that Daniel Wharley's right was vested in E. B. his Assignee.
