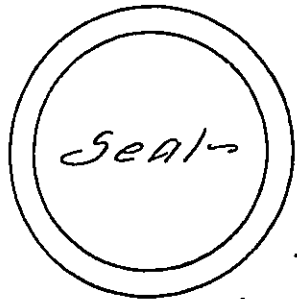


Pensilvania }



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of William Lawrence That we would grant him to take up seven foot of vacant ground in the High Street of Philadelphia interjacent between the Lotts where he now dwells and Thomas Marl These are to require thee forthwith to Survey and lay out to the sd William Lawrence the said Seven foot of vacant Ground and make Returns thereof into the general Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv'd thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 23^d of the first Month 1701.
