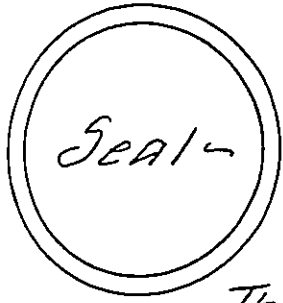


Pensylvania



By the Commissioners of Property.
 At the Request of Anthony Lee of this Province
 That we would Grant him to take up three hundred
 Acres of Land at Oley in the County of Philadia. for which
 he agrees to pay to the Proprietors use twelve pounds for
 each hundred and the yearly Quitrt. of one Shilling sterl-
 ing for ever These are to Authorize and Require thee to
 Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the said Anthony the
 said quantity of three hundred Acres of Land in the said
 place that has not been already surveyd nor Appropriated nor
 is seated by the Indians adjoyning on the surveys already made
 these are according to the Method of Townships And make a Re-
 turn thereof into the Secretaries Office, which Survey in case the
 sd Anthony Shall pay thesd Consideration money within three
 Months after the date hereof the same shall be valid otherwise
 to be void and of no Effect as if it had never been made nor
 this warrant ever Granted. Given under our hands and the Seal
 of the Province at Philadelphia the 20th day of Octobr. Anno
 Dom. 1716.
